Eligibility: Each team must have a manager, referees and five to eight players. The

manager may be one of the players.

Australian teams – players must be affiliated with their State Croquet

Association.

International teams – players must be members of organisations recognised by the WGU. Other international players will be welcomed at the discretion of the National Coordinator. Gateball Australia has registered the event with the appropriate authorities to ensure that players who need visas are dealt with as soon as possible. Number of Teams: The competition will be limited to 32 teams. Applications will be processed

on a first-come-first-received basis. Team managers will be notified if their

nomination has been successful.

Equipment: Gateball courts will be prepared with lines, gates, balls and scoreboards.

Players shall provide their own sticks and players' bibs.

Balls will also be provided for practice.

Rules: Matches will be played under the 2019 World Gateball Union rules.

Conditions: The competition will be conducted according to the polices of Gateball

Australia, the Australian Croquet Association and the Victorian Croquet

Association.

Referees: All matches will be conducted with a refereeing team. All teams will have

refereeing duties, each team needs referees, recorders and linespeople. Australian teams without qualified referees must have a referee in training.

Match Format: Matches will be played in one or more block draws, with a final series

comprising of a grand final and semi-finals, depending on the number of blocks. Final details will be available when the number of entries is known.

The Event Management Team will decide the final format.

Dress Code: Teams are required to wear a uniform. As a minimum, this includes

matching shirts and similar pants. A combination of long-sleeve and short-sleeve shirts and long and short pants is acceptable. Flat soled sporting

shoes should be worn. It is advisable to have a hat.

Bad Weather: The Event Management Team reserves the right to change the format of play

and make other changes as may be necessary in the event of unfavourable

weather.
