CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR NEW ZEALAND GATEBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS 7TH & 8TH MARCH 2020

Events will run according to the "Official Gateball Rules Guide for Referees 2015" as published by the World Gateball Union www.gateball.or.jp/wgu

- 1. Each team must have a manager and five to eight players. The Manager may be one of the players. All players must be registered with Croquet New Zealand, affiliated within their own country's membership or a member of a country's organisation which is recognised and collaborates with the World Gateball Union.
- 2. The Events of the competition shall be played in a Round Robin or Block Format depending on number of entries.
- 3. All games shall be conducted with a Referee and a Recorder. Players shall be required to assist with refereeing, recording, scoring and assisting as linesmen.
- 4. Players shall provide their own stick, scoring watch (not mandatory) and teams to provide arm bands and number identity bibs.
- 5. All players are required to play in clothing that is uniform for their team.
- 6. Play will start at 8.30 A.M. with players' briefing and warm up from 8.00 A.M.
- 7. The tournament Manager has final decision concerning all matters affecting the running of the events.
- 8. The manager of each Team and captain of Doubles must report to the Tournament Manager before the start of the event with their list of players in the event.
- 9. Results will be posted on <u>www.gateballscore.com</u>.
- 10. Rose Gardens Croquet Club will be open on Friday 6th March from 10.00 A.M. 4.00 P.M. for practice and registration of teams.
