CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR NEW ZEALAND GATEBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS 5-7 FEBRUARY 2021

- 1. Events will be run according to the "Official Gateball Rules Guide for Referees 2019" as published by the World Gateball Union www.gateball.or.jp/wgu
- 2. All players in the tournament must be registered with CNZ, affiliated with their own country's membership or a member of a country's organisation which is recognised and collaborated with the World Gateball Union.
- 3. The events of the competition shall be played in a full Round Robin or Block Format, depending on number of entries.
- 4. All games shall be conducted with a Referee, Assistant Referee and a Recorder. Players will be required to assist with refereeing, recording, scoring and assisting as lines-people.
- 5. Players shall provide their own stick, scoring watch (not mandatory) and teams shall provide arm bands & number identity bibs.
- 6. All players are required to play in a team uniform.
- 7. Players will start at 8.30 am with a players' briefing and warm up from 8.00 am each morning.
- 8. Rose Gardens Croquet Club will be open on Thursday 4 February from 10.00 am 4.00 pm for practice and registration of teams.
- 9. The tournament will commence on the Friday, starting with the Teams Event. The Doubles Event will start on Saturday morning or afternoon, depending on the number of entries.
- 10. The tournament manager has final decision concerning all matters affecting the running of the events.
- 11. Each team in the Teams Event must have a manager and 5 to 8 players. The manager may be one of the players.
- 12. The manager of each team and the Captain of Doubles pairs must report to the tournament manager before the start of the event with their list of players in the event.
